Rain Barrel Maintenance

Every Rain Period	-Use the water from the barrel on a permeable surface like a lawn or garden. Direct the overflow to a rocky area to decrease the water's speed and drain it evenly.
Monthly	-Remove debris from the filter & make sure the ground is level
Seasonally- Spring	-connect the downspout inlet to the barrel so it may start collecting water -Close the spigot.
Bi-Annually- Spring/Fall	-Inspect the downspout leading to the barrel. Make sure the connection is secureClean roof gutters
Seasonally- Winter	-Disconnect the downspout inlet from the barrel so it does not collect water -Keep the spigot open



- 43% of land in DC is covered by hard surfaces
- Rain gardens soak in **30% more water** than grass
- Rain barrels can save up to 1,300 gallons of water

- **Barrels shift over time:** Annually re-level the ground under the barrel.
- Using Water: Drain your barrel monthly. Longterm sitting water can put pressure on your barrel's spigot.
- Always pick up pet poop
- Use less fertilizer, if at all
- Use a broom to clean your driveway
- Keep waste, oil, soapy water, grass, and leaves out of the storm drain
